About The Role

This is a highly rewarding and unique opportunity to help shape the future of our region. As a Local Connector, you will provide a community concierge service for new NSW Government employees, their partners and families moving to the region. This role would suit a sociable, creative, empathetic, organised person with great knowledge of their community. You will support key workers, their partners and families to move and settle into their new community and make them feel welcome by facilitating new and positive social connections.

In addition to knowledge of your local communities and regional life experiences, desirable attributes include effective communication, the ability to work flexibly, collaboratively and creatively, solve problems, plan and prioritise and be customer-service orientated. As part of the role, you must be able to work flexibly and be available to work outside normal business hours and on some weekends to meet the needs and conveniences of key workers. You will work as part of a network of Local Connectors across NSW and collaborate with key stakeholders, community groups and other parties to enhance key employee attraction, recruitment and retention.

We are seeking two local connectors, one based in Armidale for Armidale Regional and Uralla Shire Local Government Areas and another in Tamworth for the Tamworth Regional Local Government Area. Both Local Connectors are full-time roles (37.5 hours per week) for an initial 2-year contract, with the potential to extend the position depending on the outcomes and continued funding of the program.

Key Responsibilities

This role directly reports to the Executive Director of RDANI through the provision of a broad range of activities:

- Manage, facilitate and implement the key worker concierge project through stakeholder engagement, events, communications and one on one client support.
- Develop trusted relationships with clients to ascertain their needs and find solutions to improve their regional community assimilation.
- Manage the project, allocated budget, and reporting.
- Manage, facilitate and report on program progress
- Measure, monitor, evaluate and report on metrics, outcomes and impacts.
- Develop and grow stakeholder relationships, contacts, collaborators and partners.
- Consult effectively with regional stakeholders to identify key worker challenges, barriers, opportunities and solutions.
- Devise and implement solutions-focussed deliverables to improve the program outcomes and impacts.
- Prepare information on the project for internal and external communications including website, newsletter, social media, media releases and reports.
- Manage and monitor data base contacts, communications and program resources.
- Other duties as directed by the Executive Director.

- Demonstrated strong and creative communication skills that enable you to effectively communicate with people from diverse backgrounds and all walks of life.
- Demonstrated skills working with digital technology, social media tools and platforms.
- High level project management, monitoring, reporting and evaluation skills.

- Outgoing, enjoy talking to people and find value in helping others.
